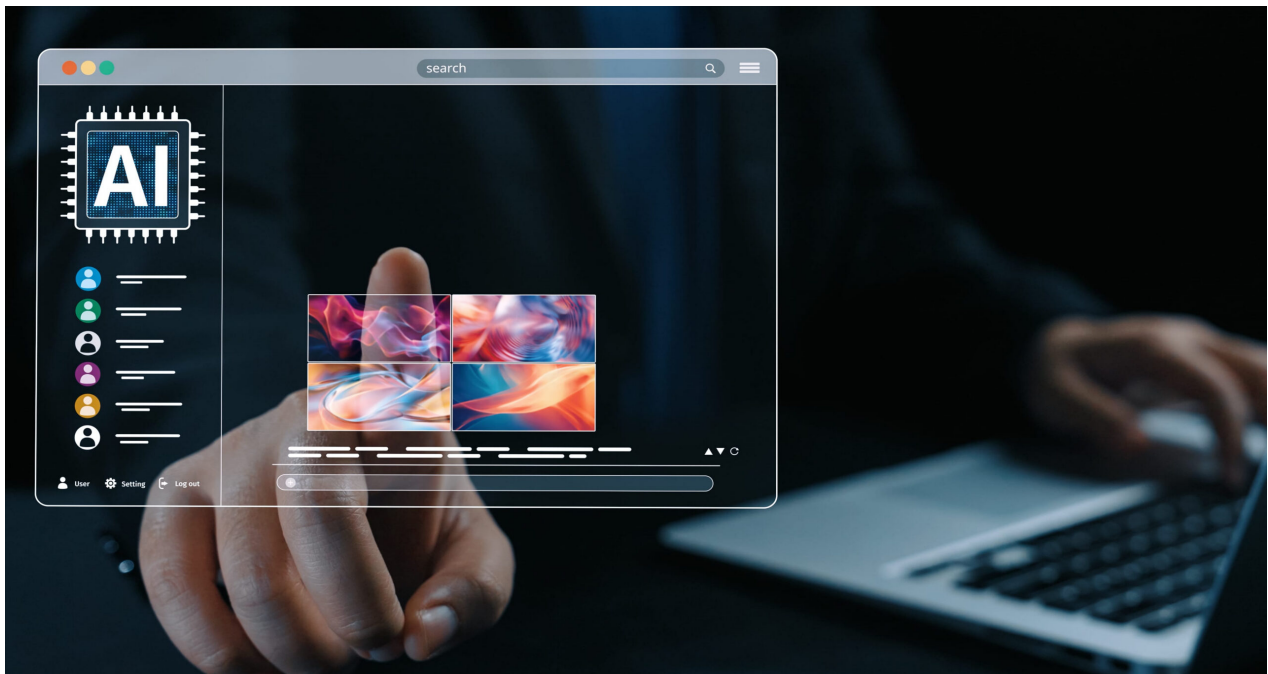




# Evolve with Jeff Launches AI Video Generation Service for Creators Over 40

The guide closes with a frequently asked questions section addressing common concerns raised by beginners.
